16th INTERNATIONAL YOUTH BOWLING TOURNAMENT (October 28th, 29th and 30th 2011)

1. Name of the tournament : **16th J.I.C. Sinjoor International Youth Tournament.**
2. This international youth tournament (scratch) is organized for youth players in regulation with their national federation and for the Y.I.C. members of the different national YIC-Clubs. Only amateur players with an official federation license are allowed to participate in the tournament.
3. The tournament will be organized and played in THE BOWLINGSTONES, Autolei 113, 2160 Wommelgem, on October 28th, 29th and 30th 2011. The tournament is homologated by the BTBF under number **2012/01**. The tournament is organized by Bowlingclub Y.I.C. SINJOOR.

4. The contestants will be classified according to the official playerlists of the BTBF. Foreign players with a Belgian license need to present their BTBF-License at the subscription in the tournament. Foreign players with a Belgian license will present the license of their national Federation (Article 226 of the BTBF-Rules). A declaration by their club concerning the average, is not valid and will not be taken into account. Players without an official average will be hosted automatically in the lowest category (MB or JB).
5. The bowling rules of the BTBF and the FIQ-WTBA are applicable. Only amateur players are allowed on the tournament.
6. 1 (one) Re-entry per player is allowed. A player, who made a reservation for a re-entry, will be obliged to play this re-entry and to pay for it.

The entry fee is paid at the moment of presentation in the tournament. Players of a club in a radius of less than 30 kilometers of the organizing Bowlingcenter will play their qualifying games obligatory on Saturday. Exceptions on his rule can be admitted by the tournament management. The maximal number of players per lane is fixed at three (3).
9. The allocation of the starting lanes will be done by the organizing committee following the subscriptions and Before the start of the qualifying round.
10. The tournament will be played in 6 separated categories (boys and girls separate):

Category A		From 18 to 23 year on 01.06.2011
Category B	+160	From 15 to 18 year on 01.06.2011
Category C	Upto 159	From 15 to 18 year on 01.06.2011
Category D	+135	From 12 to 15 year on 01.06.2011
Category E	Upto 134	From 12 to 15 year on 01.06.2011
Category F		From 6 to 12 year on 01.06.2011

The number of qualifying games will be six (6), in European playing system. The players will change lanes after every game.

11. After the qualifying round the qualified players, minimum 25% per categorie with a minimum of 3 players, will play the semi-finals over 3 games. In case of a tie a roll-off over 2 frames will decide over the final ranking of the concerned Finalists. After the semi-finals the best 3 players will play a knock-down final to indicate the tournament winner. The match between the numbers one and two will be played in 2 games. In case of a tie a complete game will be played to indicate the winner. The pinfall of the qualifying round is retained in the finals.

From the participants, who played in one of the Friday squads, the first placed in each category will be qualified automatically for the semi finals. These places are a part of the minimum of 3 players, that will qualify in each category for the semi finals.

The score, with which a player qualifies, will be applied in the semi finals.

12. The participants will wear obligatory a poloshirt showing the name or logo of their club. Wearing jeans is not allowed. No player is allowed to smoke and to consume alcoholic beverages in the Bowlingcenter during the tournament in the player area. It is forbidden to eat in the players area. It is also forbidden to use mobile phones in the players area. The Bowlingcenter is equipped with an automatic scoring system. A referee will be present during the complete playing period of the tournament. Each complaint regarding the correctness of the scores has to be done within 15 minutes after the official publication of the results of the qualifying round. Only official coaches or trainers are allowed in the players area. The players are requested to be present in the Bowlingcenter at least 30 minutes before the start of their qualifying round and to present themselves immediately at the official table. Games in a qualifying round cannot be overhauled due to the computer system. Players, who will participate in the tournament, are not allowed to play in a boosterteam. Only one booster-player per qualifying round will be allowed to complete a pair of lanes. Also the booster-players will be submitted to the BTBF-rules. Each contestation, not mentioned in this flyer, will be settled by the Organizing Committee.
